

# African-American Leaders for Tomorrow

## Sponsored by the California Legislative Black Caucus

The **2020 African-American Leaders for Tomorrow (AALT) Program** is a four-day long residential summer program held on the campus of California State University Dominguez Hills (CSUDH). Ninety students are hand selected to receive leadership training and attend workshops on topics such as the legislative process and civic engagement. Students are housed on the campus of CSUDH. Meals, program materials, as well as transportation during the conference is provided at no cost to the participants. For students living outside of Los Angeles and Riverside Counties, transportation to the conference will also be provided based on where you live.

### Application Requirements:

Student who are currently incoming high school sophomores or juniors with a 2.5 or higher GPA and are in good academic standing as of January 1, 2020 are eligible to apply. Applicants must also:

- Demonstrate leadership potential (i.e. involvement in student government, community leadership or similar activities)
- Provide current high school transcript
- Submit two letters of recommendation
- Write two essays (2 required)
- Forward a photo
- Comply to all agreements (see website to download fillable documents)

### Deadlines:

**February 3, 2020** - Applications will be available

**April 27, 2020** - Application deadline

**April 28 – May 4, 2020** - Review and selection process

**May 15, 2019** - Students notified via email by 9 PM

**July 8 – 11, 2020** - The conference will be held on the campus of CSUDH



### Note:

Students may bring spending money for snacks, souvenirs, etc. Travel arrangements are made for students living outside of Los Angeles and Riverside Counties depending on where you live. All conference participants will stay in campus housing and be supervised at all times.
