

# CLBC Scholarship Program

The California Legislative Black Caucus (CLBC) Scholarship Program was established to assist deserving students by offering financial assistance to help meet educational expenses. This program provides tuition assistance to enable students to fulfill their higher education goals.

## Who can apply?

- High school seniors enrolled and graduating from a school in the State of California for the 2019-2020 academic year
  - Provide written proof of acceptance at an accredited institution of higher learning for fall 2020
  - In good academic standing

**OR**

- Full-time students currently enrolled at an accredited College or University
  - Provide proof of high school diploma in the State of California
  - In good academic standing

## To be eligible for selection, candidates must:

- Complete the online CLBCPI Scholarship application form below
- Have a minimum GPA of 2.5
- Submit personal statement essay
  - What is the value of education to you?
  - 750 words or less
- Two signed letters of recommendation
  - Dated within the last 90 days
  - One from a community member not related to you
  - One from a school representative
- Copy of the most recent transcript
  - Dated within the last 90 days
  - Must show classes currently enrolled in (2<sup>nd</sup> Semester or Spring 2020)
- Proof of high school diploma from a school in the State of California  
*(college students only)*
- Recent photo of the applicant
- The deadline to submit the scholarship application is Monday, April 6, 2020

# African American Leaders for Tomorrow (AALT)

**The 2020 African-American Leaders for Tomorrow (AALT) Program** is a four-day long residential summer program held on the campus of California State University Dominguez Hills (CSUDH). Ninety students are hand selected to receive leadership training and attend workshops on topics such as the legislative process and civic engagement. Students are housed on the campus of CSUDH. Meals, program materials, as well as transportation during the conference is provided at no cost to the participants. For students living outside of Los Angeles and Riverside Counties, transportation to the conference will also be provided based on where you live.

## **Application Requirements:**

Student who are currently incoming high school sophomores or juniors with a 2.5 or higher GPA and are in good academic standing as of **January 1, 2020** are eligible to apply. Applicants must also:

- Demonstrate leadership potential (i.e. involvement in student government, community leadership or similar activities)
- Provide current high school transcript
- Submit two letters of recommendation
- Write two essays (2 required)
- Submit a photo
- Comply to all agreements (see website to download fillable documents)
